



## Area F Guidelines: Associated Dental Sciences (Dental Hygiene)

Area F for majors within the Allied Health Professions consist of 18 hours of lower-division (1000- and 2000-level) courses related to the specific health professional program of study or be prerequisite to courses required in the major.
