PURPOSE: To release Academic Release 1.7, which includes the following:

- Collection of Curriculum Data (modification)
- Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP 2020) Codes (modification)
- Duolingo English Test (new)
- Decommission of the Course Data Submission Summary Report

This collection will open on June 16, 2020.

SOURCE: Information Technology Services (ITS)

PREREQUISITE: The prerequisite for the Academic Release 1.7 is Data Collection ETL (ZADMETL) 1.3.

IMPACT: Implementation of the Academic Release 1.7 is mandatory.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILE VALIDATION (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql):

After downloading the file (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql), you may run the following checksum command to validate the file is the same as the one located in the directory above:

1. Download the package (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql) file to a local server.
2. Run the following command, replacing to make sure the checksum info is the same as it was when ITS posted the package: `$md5sum CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql`
3. Verify the checksum info you get from the above command. It should be the same as below:

```
e9f4cd9817a94e5f0412c6ffa9d9adc0  
CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql
```
